PARISH COUNCILLORS' ALLOWANCES

Southwater Parish Council gave notice that at its meeting on 15th November 2023 it made a Scheme of Members' Allowances following receipt by the Parish Council of the recommendations of the Parish Remuneration Panel. In reaching its decision to pay Members' allowances it has had regard to the Panel's report.

Parish Remuneration Panel's recommendations	Parish Council's decisions
<ul style="list-style-type: none">To pay all Parish Councillors a basic allowance of not exceeding £430 per annum	<p>The annual rate set would be £200.00</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Not to pay a differential allowance to the Parish Council's Chairman	<p>To pay a Parish Council Chairman allowance of £400 for the Year.</p> <p>This allowance falls outside the Members' Allowance Regulations and is payable under Local Government Act 1972 S15 (5)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">To pay a travelling and subsistence allowance in respect of agreed parish duties, such allowance to be in accordance with the Local Government Staff Scheme of Travel and Subsistence Allowances (modified in respect of mileage for Members' training purposes) adopted by Horsham District Council and modified by the recommendations at para 7.	<p>That Travel and Subsistence Allowance be paid to Members in relation to their duties during the year.</p> <p>Budget provision set annually.</p> <p>£150 for 2023/24 onwards.</p>

The Scheme of Members' Allowances took effect from 1st April 2018.
