From the vicar's pen,

On Saturday 6th September 12-4 pm we have the Church Fair and Fun Dog Show in the vicarage garden. Hope to see many of you there.

This month, children, young people and staff start a new academic year. Our prayers and good wishes for those either returning or joining the local academies, schools and preschools. Prayers for those going to universities and others starting new jobs too. Hope that this will be a peaceful year for all of us.

As we start a new academic year, uncertainty, fear and apprehension can come with it. Often when the disciples were overcome with fear, God in Jesus comes to them and says, "peace be with you." For instance, the risen Jesus came to his disciples and said, "peace be with you." St Chrysostom reflects on how St John connects the greeting of peace with Jesus's showing of his crucified hands and torn side—this conjunction of words and gesture reveals the true nature of the Cross itself as an instrument of peace. What kind of peace does God offer? There is certainly nothing glib about the peace God offers—he is not telling them to 'calm down!'—rather, this gift of peace is one which heals and energises. It is insistent. Jesus bestows this peace upon his disciples repeatedly. It keeps knocking at the door, and they can't avoid it.

The gift of Christ's peace is intimately bound up with the forgiveness of sins—yours, mine, others. So often, the world remains sunk in a morass of despair; cycles of violence, jealous anger, the endless drive for dominance and control and exploiting some of the most vulnerable of our brothers and sisters, from Gaza to Sudan, from Ukraine to Yemen. It is into this febrile locked-in situation, too, that God in Jesus wants peace, armed only with the Cross—his instrument of peace—for those whose hearts dare to receive it and then work for peace.

If we accept God's gift of peace, we also need to accept that it will change us so that we no longer live just for ourselves, but for God and His people, reconciled to one another in Him.

St Cyril of Alexandria, writing in the fifth century, noticed how Jesus replenishes and augments the gift of the Holy Spirit, constituting a new creation. Peace is heavenly. With it we become a new creation.

May peace and joy be with us all this academic year and always.

News from your District Councillor Alex Jeffery Horsham's Local Plan to be withdrawn – what happens next?

This month, Horsham District Council's (HDC) cabinet are due to decide on whether to withdraw our Local Plan. This is an important decision with Local Plan's shaping communities whilst also playing a key role in guiding accompanying infrastructure – even if not directly in the power of the local authority.

A Local Plan is the main tool at HDC's disposal to have any control over local development. Contrary to the wishes of some, development to some degree will always come, it is simply not realistic under the current national planning system to demand a halt to all development. The reality is we are in dire need of genuinely affordable housing, including social housing. Local Plans are not perfect, I have my own criticisms of them however it is the best tool we have.

When I stood for election back in 2023, I stood on a platform to pass a Local Plan to end the planning chaos that Southwater and the wider district had been subjected to during the tenure of the previous administration as covered in my last article.

Since then, new information has come to light with FOI's showing clear interference by the Government with the 'independent' Planning Inspectorate, with direction given by the Minister for Housing to fail Local Plans that did not align with the Governments 1.5m home ambition. Local Plans for Mid Sussex and Bournemouth & Christchurch have suffered a similar fate. So, the question is, what next? At the Scrutiny Committee held at the end of July, it was agreed that the Council would write to the Planning Inspectorate one last time to request the process be revisited.

If this fails to yield the result, we hope then the Cabinet are minded to move forward with officially withdrawing our Local Plan and beginning afresh immediately. This will be a testing time with many speculative applications coming in, the most recent of which being the Horsham Golf & Fitness Village application that despite being refused by the Council was overturned on appeal by The Planning Inspectorate, again on dubious grounds.

As your councillor, I am determined to defend Southwater from speculative developments, as a council we have taken this opportunity to tighten our defences against speculative developments. I will continue to stand up for the residents of Southwater and continue to fight in your best interests.

Furthermore, this award shows that your council has gone above and beyond legal obligations; you lead your community and continuously seek opportunities to improve and develop even further."

In addition to recognising high standards in governance and transparency it is also in recognition of Southwater Parish Council's leadership role in the community. It reflects years of hard work, dedication and commitment.

Executive Officer & Responsible Financial Officer, Justin Tyler, who led the application process, said: "This achievement has been a couple of years in the making. Southwater Parish Council is incredibly fortunate to have such committed, skilled and capable officers who consistently go above and beyond. Their hard work often takes place behind the scenes, but it is their determination and commitment to servicing Southwater that has made this recognition possible. We are blessed to have such a strong and capable team, and I want to publicly thank them for everything they do. The Council acknowledged that while reaching Gold is a significant milestone, the work does not stop there. It will continue to seek opportunities to improve and develop even further.

- Horsham Golf Club Appeal SPC Update Following the Planning Inspector's decision to allow the appeal for up to 800 homes and associated facilities at the Horsham Golf Club site, SPC has taken a number of steps to explore the possibility of challenging this outcome: The Council sought detailed legal advice from specialist barristers and planning consultants on whether there were grounds to pursue a Judicial Review of the decision. While counsel concluded that a Judicial Review could not realistically succeed due to the Inspector's reliance on Horsham District's severe housing shortfall, the Council is still committed to defending the Southwater Neighbourhood Plan wherever possible in future planning cases. The Council is working with its advisors to produce a public-facing legal note for residents, and to prepare a formal complaint to the Planning Inspectorate about aspects of the decision. - Community Fridge Saves Tonnes In the three months February-April Horsham/Southwater Community Fridge collected and distributed a total of 8.7 tonnes of food that would otherwise have ended up in landfill. In May they collected 6.2 tonnes and in June a huge 8.4 tonnes. Over those five months they served an average of 46 people per session and collected a total of £382 in donations which goes towards running the fridges.



Southwater Community Police Office Think before you scoot

E-scooters are becoming a more common sight across Sussex, including here in Southwater. While they may seem like a fun and eco-friendly way to get around, it's important to remember that privately owned e-scooters are illegal to use on public roads, pavements, and cycle paths. They may only be used on private land with the landowner's permission.

At present, it is not possible to insure privately owned escooters for use on public roads. This makes them unlawful to operate in public spaces such as streets, shopping centres, parks, or pavements. If you use one in public, it may be seized under Section 165 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 due to a lack of insurance.

Causing serious harm while riding one is treated similarly to causing harm while driving a motorcycle or car.

Here in Southwater, Sussex Police working to tackle the rise in unsafe and anti-social use of e-scooters. We urge residents to stay alert to the dangers, especially if you're considering buying one for a child or young person.

Let's all play a part in keeping Southwater safe and responsible, one scooter at a time.



Southwater Local History Group A Century of Village Halls

One hundred years ago, Britain was facing a social crisis. At the end of the first world war, a million men had lost their lives and this was particularly devastating in rural communities where populations were smaller to begin with. People needed a place in which they could redevelop a sense of belonging and participation in their communities. As a result, and this applied uniquely to Britain, large numbers of village halls were created for people to gather together, both to remember the lost, and to provide spaces and amenities for social gatherings so that people could look towards the future.

Village halls quickly became a central feature of rural areas, as part of a wider movement to bring about rural regeneration.

Many village halls, including ours, were built specifically as communal buildings, while some made use of older buildings, such as converted medieval hospices, guild halls, and occasionally even older structures. Many contain war memorials or are memorials in themselves and a small number are in "thankful villages" in celebration of the return of everyone from that village who went to war

Southwater Village Hall was just one of many celebrating their 100th an-



niversary this year. Ours was officially opened on 11th June 1925 following a fund-raising campaign by Southwater W.I.

Originally timber, clad with corrugated iron, with a corrugated iron roof, it has since undergone as many alterations as George Washington's



apocryphal axe, re-clad, re-roofed, re-wired, a new floor and additional extensions, including The Robert Piper Room at the rear.

In common with thousands of other village halls, it has served the community in a variety of ways. During WWII, it served as a school for evacuee children and since inception has been home to the WI, pre-schools, churches, clubs and societies, flower and produce shows, pantomimes, a ballet school, a library and a polling station.

Last but but no means least, it is home to the Southwater Local History Group!

Notes from the Past.... By Robert Piper

If we look back to 1880 when summer turned to autumn, wheat was being sold at £11-12-6 per load (RPI £1211.67). In September 1885 it was reported that a flower show was held on Wednesday 26th August at West Grinsted by kind permission of Sir Walter and Lady Burrell of Knepp Castle. One of the highlights was the size and beauty of the peaches from Denne Park. The village of Southwater paid £4-13 -6 (RPI £514.93) towards running the show. The harvest thanks giving service was held at the church on 27th September. The flowers and vegetables were sent to one of the London Hospitals.

The 1905 Sunday school treat for the children was hosted by Sir William and Lady Striling -Hampton at Woodgaters. The children had games and singing until 4.30pm followed by afternoon tea. There was some sad news. Mrs Sayer was killed when she fell from her cycle in the village. On August 8th 1915 the village held an open air service in the station yard (where the surgery is today) to mark the anniversary of the outbreak of the war. Miss Emily Chartler of the store (where the Post Office is today) was fined £0-2-6 (RPI£11.13) at Horsham court for riding her cycle without a light. Master James Eames of Southwater Wesleyan Chapel Sunday school, sent sandbags to the front. He revived a thank you letter back from the Colonel of the 8th Royal West Kents Regiment.

In 1935 the choir summer outing for 14 boys and 13 adults in two coaches to Bognor cost £4-6-6 (RPI £254.18) and £3-19-2 (RPI£244.02) for the lunch and tea

In September 1945 Mr H Plummer of London was found stealing sugar and hiding it in Worthing Road. He was fined £2 (RPI £74.79). A 3 bed semi-detached house in Southwater in need of re-decorating and an outside toilet was for sale at £1100 (RPI £41,134.89)



Give Wasps a Break

Wasps! What's the point of them? They spoil picnics and sting people! Before you get out the fly swat or bug spray, you might be interested to hear why these are actually eco-heroes.

Common wasps (Vespula vulgaris) work hard as a team all summer to feed and house their queen and her larvae until late summer when the nest has grown huge and the queen quits her egg laying. Now the workers are left jobless and disorientated and, as adult wasps are unable to digest solid food and need sugary liquid to survive, they become uncontrollably and insatiably hungry. Hence their cravings for sweet, sugary stuff.



By the end of summer they will all have died apart from the queens who will abandon the nests to hibernate somewhere safe, ready to start again next year.

But this hungry time is when they're pesky and a bit scary! When we wave our arms around to try and swat them away, they think they're being attacked and call on their mates to help them out. "The gang" all pile in ready for a punch up and we get stung. So your best bet is to keep calm, stay still and they'll focus on what you're eating/drinking rather than what you're doing.

As you watch them devouring your cream tea, you might be interested to know that they play a vital role in the ecosystem. We think of bees and butterflies when we think of pollinators but wasps are pollinators, too. In fact there are over 160 plants that rely on wasps for pollination. And many wasp species put it about a bit – in other words, they'll pollinate a wide variety of plants and not just one species like a specialist pollinator would.



They're among the top predators of other insects such as aphids, caterpillars and ants so they're good news for gardeners and might even be employed as a sustainable answer to agricultural pests.

Some early research suggests that their saliva and venom might be used for antibiotics and for cancer treatment, too.

So when those heroic, but starving, and doomed wasps try to muscle in on your picnic, why not give them a break and put a bowl of sugary drink or leftover jam out somewhere out of your way so you can enjoy the last of the summer weather and they can enjoy a last meal in peace?


