From the vicar's pen,

Easter (a man who was dead rose again) is the greatest good news the world will ever hear. Good Friday is on the 18th and following that we celebrate Jesus' resurrection on the 20th April. William Tyndale, translator of the Bible, wrote, 'Evangelion (that we call gospel) is a Greek word and signifieth good and merry, glad and joyful tidings that maketh a man's heart glad, and maketh him synge, daunce and leape for joye.' Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb, says the scripture. That is a dark beginning, in the dark, before dawn it was discovered that the tomb was empty. Let's be clear about these gospel tidings—Easter is not one another good news bulletin. This is not good news of the kind that declare the English have just beaten the Australians by an innings and two hundred runs. Good news, but more matches to play. It is not the birth of a grandchild news, the beginning of something new and different. Nor is it even the news that the man who fell off the fishing boat at sea has been discovered alive and well. It is not another happy ending story to what looked like a sad tale. Easter is good news for all time and for everyone – you, me and everyone literally. Good Friday and Easter tell us about the possibility of sins being forgiven, new life in the present and assurance of life with God in Christ after this life in this world. We really should be merry and glad, dance and leap for joy.

Jesus lives life fully and dies fully. According to John's gospel, he dies saying, 'It is accomplished'. Jesus lives the human story and fulfils it. Jesus is the human story. A life lived in hope, grace and goodness, that ends in death. Except, of course, it doesn't end in death. Easter is relevant for you and me because it teaches us about life after death.

Easter story is matchless; it is the whole story, the real story. Jesus has lived our life, died our death; and now lives. The grace and glory will never end. Easter is the greatest news that the world will ever hear. Eternal and everlasting life not death, light not darkness, grace not betrayal, glory not shame, love not hatred will triumph. As one song writer puts it, "Life is worth the living just because He lives."



SOUTHWATER VILLAGE HALL IS 100 YEARS OLD!!

Southwater Village Hall held its official opening ceremony on Thursday 11th June 1925 after Southwater WI started fundraising in 1921 for a parish hall.

After lengthy and determined fundraising over the next few years, sufficient funds were raised to go ahead. Although originally proposed to be built of brick, cost considerations meant that the hall had to be built of timber, clad with corrugated iron, with a corrugated iron roof. The building was erected by local builders H Baker & Son at a total cost of around £690. The hall was officially opened as a "centre for social activities" by Sir Lancelot Aubrey-Fletcher, whose family donated the land.

Over subsequent years, many improvements and alterations have been made to the original building, including a rear extension (now the 'Robert Piper Room'), the building has been re-clad, re-roofed, re-wired, new floor and recently a new green heating system installed and the kitchen refurbished. Externally, a car park extension has been added, as well as a dedicated play area and outdoor classroom for the Pre-School. During the War the hall was used as a school for children evacuated from London and this educational use has continued with the Southwater Village Hall Pre-School having been the hall's primary user for over 50 years. As probably the only provision for under-5s in the village for many years, many local residents went there, followed by their children and grandchildren.

For many years the hall was the home of Southwater Amateur Dramatic Society and saw many productions on its stage. Southwater Horticultural Society was also a long-term user and regularly used the hall for meetings, annual shows, plant sales etc and also for annual pantomime productions. The hall is, through the Elim Church, also a place of worship and over the years has been a library and has been home to four badminton clubs. In the 60s it hosted South London group 'The Spirits' featuring an electric organ and a Beat Group called 'The Blueberries'.

For over 30 years the hall has been home to the Trefoil Guild and Brownies and today's regular users include Elsden Dance Company, Southwater WI, Southwater Art Club, AA, Games Afternoon and Welcome Club and can be booked for children's parties on Sunday afternoons.

Letter from Alex Jeffery. HDC Councillor for Southwater South & Shipley Ward Update on Southwater Paddling Beach

As we begin to move out of the dark winter months into spring, many leisure activities come to mind with many looking forward to the longer days and lighter evenings. After spring comes summer which gets many of us thinking about sun, sea and relaxation - with the country park and paddling beach situated in the heart of the village what better way to spend a summer's day lounging on the grass banks with the option of a dip to cool off when the temperature gets a little too much.

Many will already be aware that last year I successfully lobbied for the removal of the booking system at the paddling beach. I am delighted to say that after trailing the removal of the booking system that this went without a hitch and as such the booking system will not be returning anytime soon. Last year I informed residents that I would look into the removal of the fencing erected during the covid-19 pandemic should no issues arise. Following a recent poll conducted in which a seismic 91% of residents who took part would like to see the fencing removed, I will be scheduling meetings with officers at HDC to look at removal of the fencing in time for this summer so that residents can once again move freely between the paddling beach and grass banking as before. I do however acknowledge that there will be others who take a different view, my door is always open to feedback.

HDC Budget For 2025/26 Financial Year

In other news, in February HDC passed a balanced budget for the 2025/26 financial year without any cuts to frontline services. A council tax increase of 2.7% was agreed raising the annual council tax bill from HDC by £4.67 per year for a band D property whilst still securing the lowest council tax in Sussex.

We understand that the cost-of-living crisis is still affecting many residents which is why HDC has introduced up to 100% council tax relief for those struggling most in our District. If you believe you qualify please contact me or HDC directly.

Finally, I will be hosting my next District Councillor surgery on Saturday 19th April at The Selsey Arms, Coolham.

Here's what has happened in the last month and what's to come!

- Approval Secured for Footway Improvements at Nutham Lane and Cedar Drive Southwater Parish Council (SPC) is pleased to share an update on the Community Highways Scheme application regarding the much-needed footway improvements at the junction of Nutham Lane and Cedar Drive. West Sussex County Council has approved this proposal for inclusion in their works programme, with feasibility and design set to take place across the financial year 2025/26. The scheme aims to enhance pedestrian safety and accessibility by installing a fomalised footway on the grass verge between the junction of Nutham Lane and Cedar Drive and the nearby bus stop on Cedar Drive. The path will provide a safer walking route for residents and visitors and help ensure better connectivity in the area. For more info visit https://www.southwater-pc.gov.uk/news
- · Consultation on Proposals for a Mayoral combined Authority Now Open - The Deputy Prime Minister, Rt Hon Angela Raynor has announced that Sussex will be one of the places on the Devolution Priority Programme and that the Government will be moving to consult on the formation of a strategic combined authority and elected mayor. Also included in the announcement is that West Sussex County Council, and other authorities on the list, will not be holding elections this year. A consultation on proposals for a Mayoral Combined Authority for Sussex and Brighton is now open, inviting residents, businesses and organisations to have their say before the deadline on 13 April. Residents and stakeholders are encouraged to take part and share their views by visiting the Government's website at Sussex and Brighton Devolution. Currently some 41.5% of the rubbish in an average Horsham District waste bin is made up of food waste.

It will comprise seven units ranging from 8,325 sq ft to 33,940 sq ft.The projected gross development value is approximately £27m, with units available on both a freehold and leasehold basis.

More Tales from the Brickworks

Visiting Southwater Country Park nowadays it's hard to visualise it as a site of a thriving industry, the huge pits from which the clay for the famous Southwater bricks was extracted and manufactured in the brick kilns where now the business park stands, overlooking the lake. It seems like only yesterday that the last chimney was was blown up in 1983. Who could have envisaged just what it would look like now, with happy visitors enjoying the small beach area, swimming and paddling in the safer area.





But this is not the first time that swimming took place here. During WWII, Woodgetters in Shipley Road was commandeered by the War Office and Canadian soldiers were billeted there. The Cock Inn, now The Tipsy Fox, was a favourite haunt, as were the weekly dances at the Village Hall, and more than one romance began there and at least one Canadian soldier married, working at the brickworks for a short time before returning to Canada to find a home for his new family, who followed him shortly after. Another very popular activity was swimming in the clayhole lake. Many of the local lads would join them, learning to swim, although it was rather dangerous, the water as now being deep and cold. Nevertheless a swimming club was formed and continued for many years.

Swimming in the main part of the lake is quite definitely to be indulged in, only taking place during the occasional triathlon, when wet suits are worn for warmth and there is strict safety observed. That clay pit is very deep and very cold!

Church Lane Recycling:

In collaboration with Sussex Green Living, Southwater Parish Church and Terracycle, Sustainable Southwater has been facilitating the successful recycling of difficult-to-recycle plastics in the church car park on Church Lane since 2021 where there is also a Salvation Army clothes bank. But, as supermarkets have taken on more of the responsibility for recycling waste plastics, so the Church Lane facility has changed what it will accept, going forward. Church Lane Recycling will no longer accept soft plastics (eg. plastic bags and wrappers) as the supermarkets will take this material.

But they will take a range of other hard-to-recycle items such as spectacles, asthma inhalers, disposable razors, toothbrushes, contact lens cases, small bottle tops, milk bottle tops, aluminium ring pulls, rubber gloves, wine corks (not plastic), water filters, pens/felt tips/highlighters, etc. postage stamps (not plastic), ink cartridges and mobile phones.

Sustainable Southwater Pop-Up:

On the second Saturday of each month, **Sustainable Southwater** has a pop-up stall in Lintot Square, outside the Co-op, from 10-12.00. They will take your old cables, chargers, small electricals, mobile phones, water filters, toner cartridges and vapes.

Hop Oast Recycling Centre

From 1st April, the recycling centre at the Hop Oast will switch to its spring/summer opening times as follows:

9am to 6pm – Monday plus Thursday to Sunday. Tuesday & Wednesday closed. You need to book online at www.westsussex.gov.uk to visit the centre.

Hard Plastics Recycling

Due to changes in the global market for hard plastic materials, as of January 2025, hard plastics **can no longer be recycled** at WSCC recycling centres, including the Hop Oast. This includes items such as plant pots, plastic garden furniture and coat hangers.

Fruit and Veg Nets

Did you know you can recycle the plastic nets that your fruit and veg come in? Snip off the metal clips and pop them in with your soft plastics to take back to the supermarket.

Battery Recycling Made Easy

And did you know how easily you can recycle small household batteries, such as AA, AAA, D, C, 6v, 9v, button, mobile phone and laptop (with the terminals taped) batteries? Pop them in a clear plastic bag and when it's full tie the top and leave it on the top of your green or blue-topped bin on collection day. No need to book. Larger batteries for cars, 12v, vapes or corroded batteries must be taken to the recycling centre.

Have you received a suspicious email from the chemist?

Action Fraud have received over 700 reports of these scams, with many of them coming from Sussex and Surrey residents.

The emails may be asking you to complete a survey and then claim a free gift, or suggesting that you have won a free prize, such as a Medicare kit and that you need to click on a link to claim it. However, these are scams, and the link will take you to a realistic looking website, under the control of the criminals, where they will steal your personal and financial data.

Some victims report being further contacted by bank impersonators with claims that payments on their cards had been attempted. These are all part of the same scam.

Our advice is not to click on links in emails and to go to the official website to check or confirm by calling the organisation. Do not use telephone numbers contained within the email.

If you have received an email which you're not quite sure about, forward it to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS): report@phishing.gov.uk

The message might be from a company you don't normally receive communications from, or someone you do not know. You may just have a hunch. If you are suspicious, you should report it. Your report of a phishing email will help us to act quickly, protecting many more people from being affected.

Notes from the Past.... By Robert Piper

Now spring is here - on 16th March 1865 the Woodman Beer House in Worthing Road (now Woodmans) opened. No one in the village signed in favour of it. On 6th April 1875 teg (young sheep) were for sale at 48s (£234.70 RPI) per head at Horsham market. In April 1885 it was reported that the new oil lamps and glasses in the main body of the church, supplied by Messer Bennetfinks, cost £14-17s-6d (£1619.93) RPI) and were used for the first time at the Good Friday service. During the school board meeting in April 1895, the members looked at transferring the school to the Horsham school board. This would add 1-1/4d in the pound (£13.93 RPI) to the rates. The Rural Dean pointed out that the monies would go to Horsham school board and may not be spent on Southwater school, so it was decided to keep the school going for one more year if the vicar was happy to keep running it. Over 109 people attended The Easter service in April 1910. The church was decorated with spring flowers for the Sunday service. The unemployment fund had a large number of unsold pimps (lighting wood) that were offered at 4s per gross (£19.97 RPI). On the 8th April 1915 the 22nd service battalion of the Royal Fusiliers put on a concert at the council school. All funds were to go to the church. Mr Edger Charman was fined 7-6s (£32.63 RPI) by Horsham court for not having dog licenses

In April 1945 the church received a donation of £25 (£914.45 RPI) to go towards the church yard fund, Mrs Jeans of Pound Farm won a special prize at the Chiddingfold Show for the best Channel Island bull. Great House farm had mangolds for sale at 50s (£91.45 RPI) per ton. The WI members were asked to knit garments for children in the occupied countries and to grow tomato plants that were grown from Canadian seed. A notice appeared in the West Sussex County Times to say that Greengarth ,Worthing Road, had been put up for sale along with 2 acres of land. It was built in 1937 and had mains water and a telephone line. Sale would be complete in 6 weeks

PASSION FLOWER AT WHEELWRIGHT COTTAGE, SOUTHWATER



The story goes that the passion flower (also known as the maypop) was discovered by 16th-century Christian missionaries in South America. The flower's distinctive characteristics reminded them of the Passion of Christ representing the suffering and death of Jesus on the cross. The different parts of the flower have features symbolising different aspects of the crucifixion.

The five petals and five sepals are said to represent the ten apostles who remained faithful to Christ at his crucifixion

The corona filaments above the petals and sepals represent the crown of thorns that Jesus wore.

The three stigmas are the three nails that held Him to the cross.

The five anthers symbolise the five wounds that He bore

Its maypop fruit is said to represent the world that Jesus saved by dying on the cross




