Berkeleys are submitting a Planning Application by summer 2022, which will provide further opportunity for residents to comment via the HDC Planning Portal.
- **Commemorative Coins** – SPC will be issuing commemorative coins (not legal tender) celebrating the Queens Platinum Jubilee to all primary and infant children attending schools in Southwater. However, if you are a resident of Southwater and your child is age 11 or under but does not attend one of three schools (Castlewood Primary School, Southwater Junior Academy and Southwater Infant Academy) and would like a coin, please contact the Parish Council.
- **Safe Space Sussex App, launched** – The App is aimed at helping people should they feel unsafe outside of their home. The app has been developed following consultation with partners and public regarding the safety of women and girls in Sussex. Over 250 businesses across West Sussex have signed up their premises and their staff have been offered basic training to assist anyone asking for help.
