- Official transfer of The Ghyll operations to CIO – Operation of The Ghyll was successfully transferred to the Southwater Ghyll Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) on the 1st November 2020. For more information, see The Ghyll Southwater Facebook page.
- Open Space incursions on SPC managed land – Possible future incursions of open space where discussed at the Finance & General Purposes Meeting of 21st October 2020. Preliminary unconfirmed estimates providing physical barriers to protect all open spaces is estimated to be at a very high cost. SPC are looking into alternative methods to prevent incursions.
- Litter Warden Retirement – Southwater Parish

- Stakers Lane Stake park update – Debris and remaining structure of the skate park has been cleared. Further consultation of design and location is underway. The existing location at Stakers Lane, provided by HDC with a 50 year lease, was following local consultation to ensure noise did not impact local residents in other areas of Southwater Village. SPC are investigating alternative locations, however this may require planning consent and lead to possible delay of skate park replacement.
- Public Right of Ways – A review of existing Public Right of Ways in the Southwater Parish area is to be conducted by the WSCC ranger. Any works that are identified by the review would be addressed accordingly.
